Entry form due on or before **Tues., July 14th 2020** [with a picture no larger than 4" x 6" attached]. One quilt per form. If you are mailing the form, give the mail at least two weeks to deliver the form. In 2005, it took 16 days for a form to reach us that was mailed from Brookings, OR. At our last quilt show there were several entered quilts that were pulled at the last minute because they weren't finished. A lot of work goes into assigning space, planning the layout and hanging quilts. It is impossible to rearrange our layout at that time so please make sure that your quilt is FINISHED BEFORE you enter it.

- Our Quilt Show is a judged show. A professionally trained judge is hired for this purpose.
- A quilt may be only shown once at the Lighthouse Quilt Guild's Quilt Show.
- The person entering the quilt must have pieced and/or quilted the quilt. All quilts will be judged.
- There is only room for **12** King sized quilts to hang. Therefore only the first 12 entry forms for King quilts will be accepted. King sized quilts will be hung on special racks.
- Only 2 quilts in each size category will be accepted from a person with no more than 8 total quilts entered.
- Longer quilts (longer than 96") will have a clean cloth placed underneath them to prevent contact with the floor.
- Please be sure to fill out the Design Source information. Check the information on your pattern or book and if necessary get permission from the quilt designer to show your quilt.
- **Hand Done:** We usually put hand done quilts into separate subcategories. Often a quilt is a mixture of machine and hand work. We need to know how much of the quilt is hand done. A quilt will be designated 'hand done' if it's 51% or more done by hand.
- A **Miniature** is a miniaturized replica of a full sized quilt that is less than 24" x 24".
- An **Art Quilt's** purpose is to be used as art, not as a bed quilt. It can be can be abstract or realistic. Materials that are unusual in traditional quilts (paint, metal, fibers, embellishments) can be used and may be three-dimensional. Art quilts are artistic statements
- **Wall Hangings** are quilts made for display on a wall and not designed for use on a bed or as a lap quilt. They may be split into large and small groups, depending on how many are entered.
- **Home Arts** [other than quilts], includes tablecloths, place mats [2], pillows, pillowcases, table runners, decorative banners, pot holders [3], tree skirts, and banners. **These items must be quilted.**

We have limited space to hang quilts so there is always a possibility that we may have to turn some quilts away. It depends not only on the number of entries but on the size of the entered quilts. Quilts will be accepted or refused on a 'first come' basis. You will be notified if your quilt cannot be entered. Get your entries in early!

QUILTS FOR SALE

If you wish to offer your quilt for sale, please put the sale price on the entry form. Quilt sales are handled through our Country Store. 15% of the sale price goes to the guild. If the buyer pays cash, the buyer may take the quilt **after** the show. If the buyer pays by check the quilt may be picked up after the check clears. The seller will then receive a check in the mail from the Lighthouse Quilt Guild. If necessary, shipping will be arranged between buyer and seller.

Bring quilts to the main building of the Del Norte County Fairgrounds located on Highway 101 N on Thurs., August 13th between 9:30 A.M. and Noon. Judging will take place on Friday, August 14th. Quilts are to be picked up at the Quilt Distribution Center (in the main building cafeteria) between 4:30 & 5:30 on Sunday, August 16 after all quilts have been removed from the show floor.
